

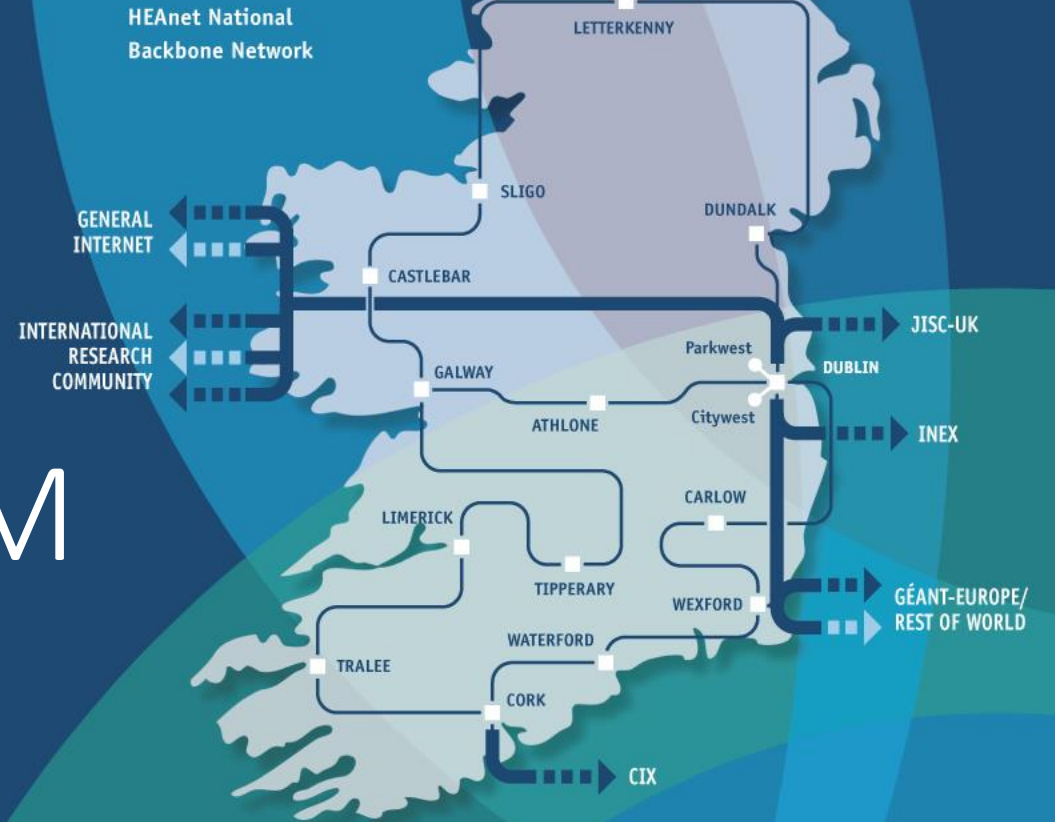

# History...

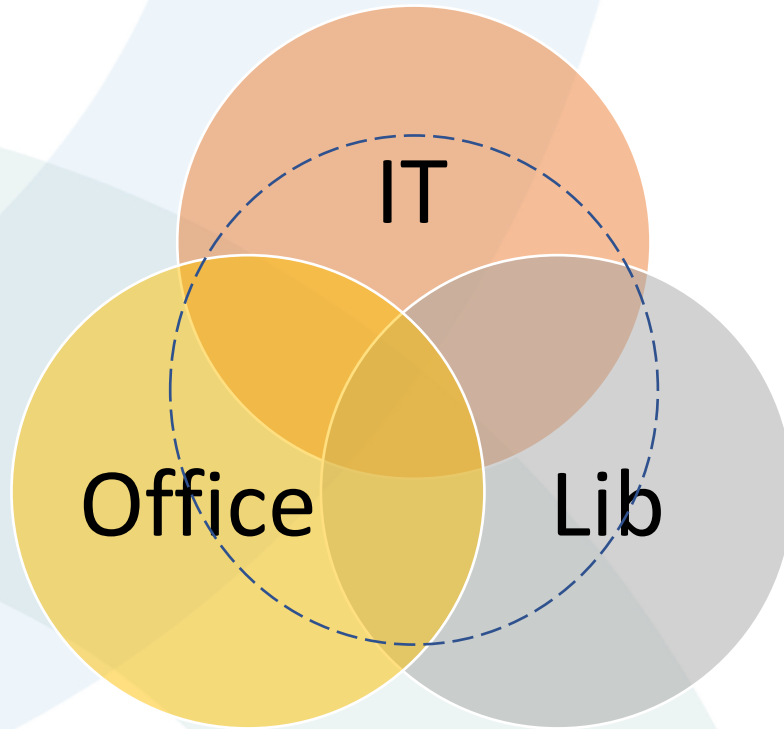
- Core network, Identity, Brokerage
- There is no history of HEAnet and technical and service aspects of RDM....
  - HEAnet has done work in the area of generic storage provisioning
- Through HEAnet's involvement in the broader EOSC activities, interest is developing including the role HEAnet could take



# Research, RDM support national landscape

- No existing structure in place to discuss at national level researcher IT requirements
- Especially with RDM, multiple stakeholders involved in supporting researchers with their IT needs
  - Policy
  - Tools and Services
  - Funding
- Share and collaborate

# RESIN : national REsearch Services and INfrastructure forum



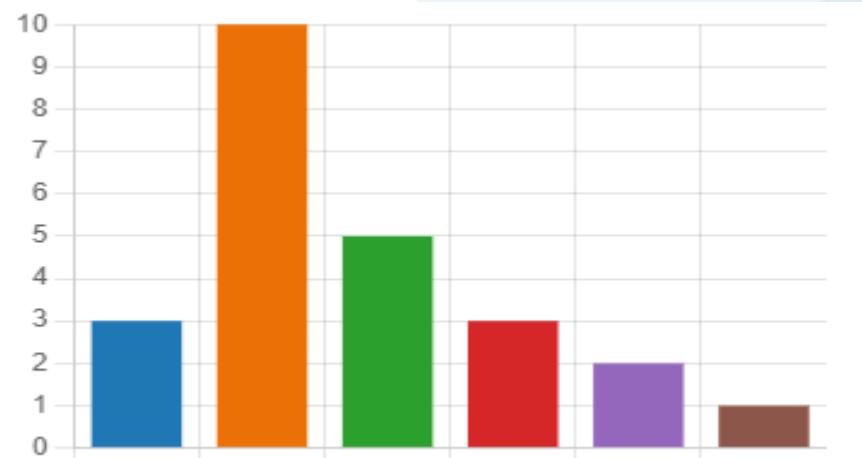
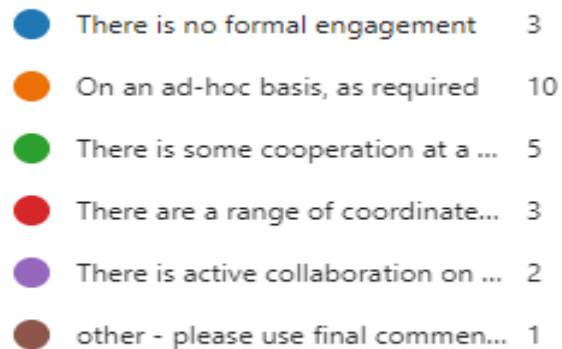

# Objectives

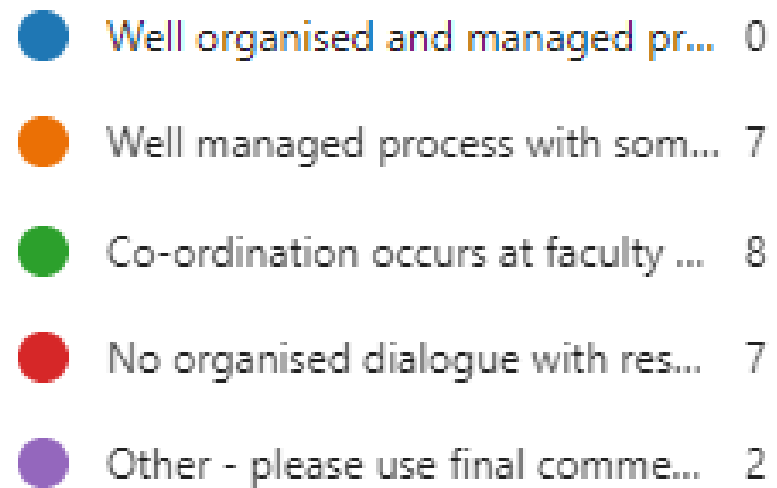

# Opportunities with EUDAT

- Open Science, FAIR RDM gaining momentum in Ireland through NORF
- No national service at present in Ireland
  - Scarcity of services at institutional level
  - Researchers “crying out” for well organised storage and RDM services
- EUDAT clear and obvious partner for technology, services and tools for RDM
  - Opportunity to work together to define a national service.
  - Concrete, detailed discussions in progress
